

**Location:** Market Square Atrium, Saint John NB

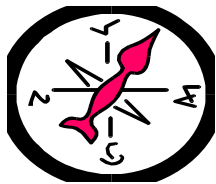
If using **GPS:** 1 Market Square Saint John, NB E2L 4Z6

**Directions to Market Square underground parking:**

From the **east** (Moncton, NS, PEI) – take McKay Highway into Saint John. Take **Exit 123 (Somerset St.)** and proceed to lights. Turn left and cross over highway – stay right and merge onto Dorchester St. At top of hill go through intersection and drive to bottom – turn right at T intersection onto Union St. Follow Union to bottom of street – left onto Smythe – underground parking is on left.

From the **west/north** (Maine, Charlotte County; Fredericton) – cross the Harbor Bridge and take Exit 122 and merge onto Main St.. At the lights turn right onto Union, left onto Smythe and parking garage is on your left.

**Note – free parking** Saturdays both on-street and at the Coast Guard lot off Water St.

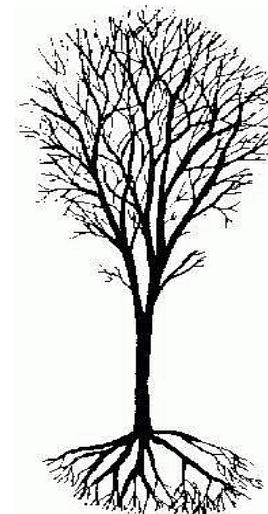
